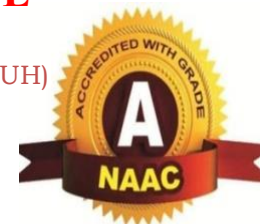

- ❖ **Promotion of Societies:** Encourage students and faculty to join and actively participate in professional engineering societies relevant to their disciplines.

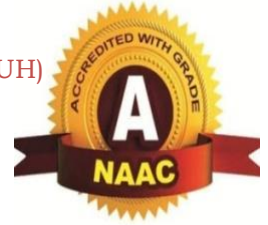
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- ❖ Organizing Society Chapters: Establish and oversee student chapters or sections of professional engineering societies within the college.
