The BOG Chairman welcomed all the members of the Governing Body Council for discussing the above Agenda. Dr P Ram Reddy, Governing Body Chairman introduced Dr. K. CSE & EEE Programs to NBA towards renewal of accreditation and applied of NBA Accreditation for the programs ECE, IT & Civil and all the Diploma programs. The

Governing Body approved all the relevant processes regarding Accreditations and made various suggestions.

Item No: 3 Application for Autonomous status

The Governing Body approved the process of applying for Autonomous Status from JNTUH & UGC.

<u>Item No: 4</u> Implementation of the Administrative Autonomy and Policies

The Governing Body reconfirmed the autonomy of administration to various administrative authorities defined in the organization chart as per the previous policies laid by the Council. The Governing Body approved the hierarchical structure for academic process and administration in the college and advised the Principal to monitor the functioning of Institutional & Departmental committees for effective implementation of the mechanism defined in the objectives and functions.
